



## Hunter/ Jumper Horse Show FAQ and COVID Guidelines

### Entries

- Entries are ONLY accepted ONLINE at [www.horseshowtime.com](http://www.horseshowtime.com). To be paid at the time of entry with a credit card. No refunds will be given unless the show is cancelled.
- Management may combine divisions with less than 3 entries, and split divisions containing more than 10 entries.
- No day of registration will be allowed.

### Biosecurity Regulations

\*There will be a staff member managing biosecurity measures. Anyone who refuses to follow guidelines will be asked to leave the facility.

- All individuals must practice social distancing (or physical distancing) at all times while on the competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.
- Masks are strongly encouraged if maintaining 6 feet distance is not possible.
- Riders are not required to wear masks but will not be penalized if they choose to wear one while competing.
- Anyone who:
  - exhibits [COVID-19 symptoms](#)
  - has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks, or
  - has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks cannot enter the competition grounds.
- Riders will be limited to one guest (not including trainer) accompanying them to the competition ground.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at warm up and competition arena, and trainers are suggested to wear gloves while adjusting jumps in warm up arena.
- Exhibitors and their guests will not be allowed to stay past the duration of their competition session to help minimize the number of people on the competition grounds.
- Exhibitors and guests are prohibited from entering the barns, office, restrooms, or arenas not used for the competition while on the competition grounds.
- The competition will be haul-in only.

### Attire/ Equipment

- Formal attire is not required but is a sign of respect to the judge. Inappropriate attire will be excused at management's discretion. Braiding is optional.

- Approved helmets and boots with a heel are required for all mounted riders.
- No martingales permitted in flat classes, optional in over fences classes.
- Boots or polos on horses are permitted in flat and over fences classes.
- Exhibitor numbers can be picked up at the registration canopy and must be clearly visible to the judge during competition.

#### Prizes

- Ribbons may be picked up at the registration canopy following the end of each division.
- High Point and Reserve High Point ribbons will be awarded for each division.

#### Schooling

- Schooling over the Hunter course will be available on Fridays from 12pm to 5pm. \$50 per horse. Please pay online with your Saturday Hunter show entries. Contact us *no later than* Wednesday before the show to reserve your scheduled arena time.
